Notes:

1. C3 – Daily duty dress.
2. C3A – Same as C3 without jacket. (Army and Air Cadets only).
3. C3B – Routine duty dress.
4. C3C – Same as C3 without tie (shirt collar is brought out above tunic collar for Army and Air Cadets only).
5. C3D – Same as C3, except shirt is replaced by crewneck sweater. (Army and Air Cadets only).
6. C3E – Service and travel dress. Same as C3 except shirt is replaced by t-shirt. Jacket carried or worn during travel.
7. C3F – Same as C3D less tunic. (Army and Air Cadets only).
8. C3 Highland – Same as C1A except the leather sporan shall be worn and white / lovat-green hose shall be worn in place of the hose-tops and spats for training and duty in all seasons. The blackcock feather shall not be worn.

C3 – Highland trousers. Same as C3 except the cadet trousers and jacket shall be worn in place of the kilt and cut away jacket doublet pattern. Sporrans, lovat-green hose and garter flashes shall not be worn. Medal ribbons are worn on the jacket. Brogue / oxford shoes are authorized where available.
